NETTING DIRECTIVE

In the EFMLG we have done some valuable work looking at the status of netting legislation in the

accession countries. I think these may have a role to play in the necessary analysis of the request

made by ISDA for a netting directive. The focus as I understand it of their request for a netting

directive relates to accession countries, present and future. It seem to me that for the community

properly to analyse the suggestion, a kind of disparity report is needed, to see what the current

gaps are in the netting regime in accession countries, before a decision can be made about whether

a directive is needed to fill them.

Do you think the EFMLG would be willing to collaborate with ISDA, ISMA and EBF (these three

being the sponsors of the main market standard contracts which relate to business that relies on

netting) in preparing such a report?

I am copying this note to Peter Werner at ISDA, with whom I have discussed the idea. I have not

mentioned any of this to ISMA or EBF.
